- The re-arrest rate for convicted child molesters is 52%
- In 80% of all non-family abductions, the first contact occurs within a quarter mile of the child's home.

Crimes Against Children Growing


In the past, crimes against children were usually associated with big cities. Today, that is no longer the case. Sexual predators have found their way into small town America, and the Internet has connected the world.
